**THERE IS HOPE "IN DEED"**

**Jeremiah 32:1-15**

**I. Doctrine: *Despite* the sins and pessimism of the faithless,**

there is \_\_\_\_\_ *Hope*—in Jesus

A. –If this was *Not True*, the World would have \_\_\_\_\_  
*Long Ago*, (2 Pet. 3:15)

B. –Hypocrites *Use Hopelessness* as a \_\_\_\_\_ for personal  
sin, (Jer. 18:12)

**II. The \_\_\_\_\_ Hope Works, in the Life of the Church,**

**vv. 1-15**

A. First, \_\_\_\_\_ Brings on Trouble, Misery, and Injustice,  
vv. 1-5

B. Then, \_\_\_\_\_ Introduces the *Oddest* Tokens of Encourage-  
ment, vv. 6-12

C. Lastly, \_\_\_\_\_ Assures that the Benefits of Christ *Will*  
Come to His people, vv. 13-15

**III. How to \_\_\_\_\_ about Life in "*The Real World*"**

A. –Recognize that what *Passes Itself Off* as \_\_\_\_\_  
probably *Is Not*, (2 Cor. 4:18)

B. –See that our \_\_\_\_\_ is in God—and *not* in the evalua-  
tions of men, (2 Cor. 5:7)

**Key Verse**—v. 15: "*For thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: Houses and fields and vineyards shall again be bought in this land.*" (ESV)
