A. THE FORCE OF TRUTH & RIGHTEOUSNESS (11; see 5:17; 1Th.1:5; Heb.4:12; see Ezk.3:27)

B. THE GOD-APPOINTED MEANS (13)

- 1. the public reading of Scripture (13; see Lk.4:16; Acts 13:15; 15:21; 2Cor.3:14; Neh.8:3f; 13:1)
- 2. the encouragement to believe & do it (11,13; Mt.28:20; Ps.143:10; see Jer.38:20; see 2Tm.4:2,5)
- 3. the instruction for knowing and understanding it (11,13,16; see 5:17; see Acts 6:2,4,7; Ezra 7:10; Neh.8:2,7,8,12)

C. THE SON-ACCOMPLISHED SOURCE AND EXAMPLE (1:1,15; see 1Cor.11:1; 1Pt.2:21f; :see Lk.3:21-23 & 4:18 with 4:16-20; 4:18,21; 4:15,31 and 19:47)

D. THE SPIRIT-APPLIED EQUIPMENT (14)

- 1. God's call and gifts go together (14; Rm.11:29; eg, Lk.3:22&4:18; 1Sm10:1,6,10; 16:13/ Num27:18f; Acts6:3,5/ 2C3:5)
- 2. hands: designation of God's calling, promise of His gifts (14; 2Tm.1:6f/Num.27:18f; Acts 13:2,3)
- 3. prophetic utterance: a more explicit promise (14; see 1:18)
- 4. note: Paul the Elder, Presbyter (14; 2Tm.1:6; 1Pt.5:1; see Acts 16:1-3; 13:1-3; 14:19-23)

III. CHARACTERISTICS OF BOTH PERSONAL & PROFESSIONAL PRESCRIPTIONS

A. MANNER (14-16)

- 1. not neglectful, careless, haphazard... (14; see Mt.22:5; Heb.2:3; see Jn.10:13)
- 2. ...but careful, diligent, practiced (15; see 2Tm.2:2,15; 3:15-17; see 1Pt.5:7)
- 3. be in; immersed; marinating; absorbed (15b; see Jer.23:18&22; 2 Cor.2:14f)
- 4. focused: painfully strenuous aim (16a; see Acts 6:2; 19:22)
- 5. persevering: painfully strenuous endurance (16b; see 2Tm.4:1-8; 1Cor.9:24-27)

B. IMMEDIATE PURPOSE & RESULT (15)

- 1. evident progress: person (12) and work (15; see 13-16)
- 2. note: progress is not perfection (see Phil.3:8-16; also 1Tm.3:4,5; Tt.1:6 w/Is.1:2; 30:9; Ezk.16:32; Jn.7:24; Job)
- 3. objection: all the other work?! (see Eph.4:11,12; 1Cor.12:4f; 1Pt.4:10,11; e.g., Rom.15:14)

IV. IMPORTANCE: THE PENULTIMATE PURPOSE & RESULT (16b; see 1Cor.10:31)

A. THE WORK OF A PASTOR IS A MATTER OF ETERNAL LIFE OR ETERNAL DEATH BOTH FOR HIMSELF AND FOR THOSE HEARING (AND SEEING) HIM! (16,12; Lk.6:39,40; see 2Tm.2:2; 3:14-17); THEREFORE:

B. PASTORS MUST PAY CLOSE ATTENTION! (13-16)

- 1. to godliness in their persons (12; 3:1f)
- 2. *to* teaching & preaching *in their* work (16; 13-15; see Ezra 7:10; Ps.40:8; Acts 20:20,26,27; 2Tm.2:2; see Acts 6:4; Paul's letters, .i.e., *prayer*)

C. THE CHURCH <u>MUST</u> PAY CLOSE ATTENTION!

- *1. to what their Pastors* do (12; see 1Cor.11:1; 4:16,17; Phil.3:17,12f)
- 2. to what their Pastors teach & preach (13-16; see Rom.10:17,16f with Mt.3:14,15; Ezk.33:6,4f; Heb.13:17; 1Th.5:12f)

D. PRAY FOR YOUR CURRENT & FUTURE PASTORS, THAT THEY WILL BE GRACED IN THEIR PERSONS, GIFTED IN THEIR WORK AND FAITHFUL IN ALL THINGS! (12-16; 2Cor.2:16; 3:5,6; see 1Cor.3:6; see 1Th.5:25; 2Th.3:1; Eph.6:19; Heb.13:18)

E. CHOOSE YOUR NEXT PASTOR WISELY, ACCORDING TO THESE TRUTHS! (12-16; see Ex.18:21f; Dt.1:13f; see Acts 6:3)
