- I. <u>REMINDER</u>: "I have written very boldly" (vv.14-16)
 - **A. Confidence:** "convinced...you yourselves are" (v.14)
 - 1. Esteeming: "full of goodness"
 - 2. Enlightening: "filled with all knowledge"
 - 3. Encouraging: "able also to admonish"
 - **B. Courage:** "I have written very boldly" (vv.15-16)
 - 1. Repetition: "to remind you again" (v.15a)
 - 2. Reason: "because of the grace...given to me" (v.15b-16)
 - a. Position: "a minister of Christ Jesus to the Gentiles"
 - b. Purpose: "that my offering of the Gentiles might be acceptable"
- II. <u>REVIEW</u>: "things pertaining to God" (vv.17-21)
 - **A. Achievement:** "reason for boasting" (vv.17-19)
 - 1. Submission: "obedience of the Gentiles" (vv.17-18)
 - 2. Saturation: "fully preached the gospel" (v.19)
 - **B. Ambition:** "aspired to preach the gospel" (vv.20-21)
 - 1. Reach: "not where Christ was named" (v.20)
 - 2. Results: "but 'THEY SHALL SEE...UNDERSTAND'" (v.21)
