Further Considerations

2 Timothy 4:1-5

What was the caution and charge that Paul gave to Timothy? What was the basis for the urgency of the admonition? What does it mean that people will have “itching ears”? In what ways do people today demonstrate an unwillingness to hear the truth? Why is it necessary to “be watchful in all things,” and how can you do this?

2 Timothy 4:6-8

What does Paul mean when he says that “the time of [his] departure is at hand”? What are some examples of when Paul had to contend for the faith (i.e. “fight the good fight”)? Why is it sometimes difficult to keep our focus on the good fight? How do you determine the course that the Lord has for you? In what ways do we encourage one another to “keep the faith”?

2 Timothy 4:9-18

What final warnings does Paul give to Timothy? Why do you think the Holy Spirit wanted the names of positive and negative examples included in this letter? What can we learn from them? How do they contrast or support Paul’s personal testimony in vv. 6-8? How does Colossians 3:1-4 challenge us to live with an eternal focus? How do you know if you are in God’s will today? What steps do we need to take to encourage ourselves to remain faithful? What do you want to be written on your tombstone?
