    - →This catalog of virtues isn't exhaustive (v. 23).
    - $\rightarrow$ Those who perfect these virtues fulfill the law (v. 23).
    - →This catalog isn't a list of rules. The Spirit works <u>virtues</u> (graces) in us to produce the righteousness demanded by the law (Romans 8:4).
    - →What we need to fulfill the law isn't legalism. What we need is the Holy Spirit.
