### ENTERING THE KINGDOM OF HEAVEN (ACTS 2:36-39)

- II. Acts 2:36-39: Who Jesus Is and What Our Response Should Be
  - A. Some Negative Responses to the Speaking in Foreign Languages (2:13)
  - B. Peter's Sermon Response to that Criticism (2:14-36)
    - 1. 2:17-21: What is happening is a fulfillment of Joel's prophecy concerning the outpouring of the Holy Spirit in the last days (see Joel 2:28-32)
    - 2. *2:22-24*: Jesus was killed according to God's plan and that God had raised him up.
    - 3. 2:25-35: The resurrection and ascension of Jesus was a fulfillment of prophecies that King David himself had made (see Ps 16:8-11; 110:1).
  - C. The Thing about Jesus That All Israel Must Know (2:36)
    - 1. Jesus is *Lord*—he is Yahweh
    - 2. Jesus is *Christ/Messiah*—he is the anointed savior-king from God
  - D. "Brothers, What Shall We Do?" (2:37)

- E. Peter's Answer (2:38-39)
  - 1. What we must do if we want to be saved from the coming judgment.
    - a. "Repent"
    - b. "...and be baptized"
      - i. What is baptism?
      - ii. What does baptizing "in the name of Jesus Christ" involve?
        - (A) It involves *calling* upon the name of Jesus Christ (see Acts 22:16)
        - (B) It involves *receiving* the name of Jesus Christ
  - 2. The benefits of repentance accompanied by baptism (v 38):
    - a. The forgiveness of sins
    - b. The gift of the Holy Spirit
  - 3. Those to whom this promise is given (v 39)
    - a. "for you…"
    - b. "and for your children..."
    - c. "and for all who are far off..."
    - d. "everyone whom the Lord calls to himself."
