- My brethren = 4th time James makes a direct appeal for a change in the Christian's normal way of doing things.
- Have not = Quit having with...
- Faith of Our Lord Jesus Christ = in our Lord Jesus Christ
- The Lord of glory = the Lord is italicized and thus not really there. Better the glorious faith in the Lord Jesus Christ = a follower of His words, ways, and perspective.
 - o Or Our Lord Jesus Christ of Glory = alluding to the true abode of Jesus in the heavenlies as opposed and in contrast to not having a place to lay His head here on earth.
- Respect of persons = deference to rich people on earth and demeaning of those who are common on earth. Favoritism

v. 3

Listen, my beloved brethren = 5th occurrence of direct appealpaired with LISTEN = remember, be swift to listen...

God has chosen = God is in charge of choosing not us

- * Heirs of the kingdom = works indicated as to hierarchy
- * Those who love Him = the real defining issue or value
