Salt is a universal preservative and flavoring agent. Since Roman times it has been highly valued and sometimes used as money. Mentioned 53 times in Scripture, salt was integral to sacrifices (Lev. 2:13), miracles (2 Ki. 2:20), and the operation of the temple (Ez. 6:9).
