Today there is just one more point to the sermon. (And a few sub points)

What is the final Point?

- Biblical preaching calls for <u>faith</u> and <u>repentance</u>. V.29-39
- 1. What did King David **predict** (v.29-31)?
  - a. David predicted something based on **God's promise** to him (v.30).
  - b. David predicted the **resurrection** of Christ (the anointed One).
- 2. What did God do (v.32-32b)?
  - a. This Jesus God raised up!
  - b. This Jesus God exalted!
- What did Jesus fulfill? He sent the <u>promise</u> of the Father the <u>Holy</u>
   <u>Spirit</u> (v.33b)
- 4. What did Peter conclude (v.34-36)? Here is the climax of his discourse;
  - a. Everyone needs to know that:
    - i. This Jesus is **Lord**.
    - *ii.* This Jesus is **The Christ**, the anointed one. Heb 11: 8-13
  - b. Everyone needs to know that this Jesus is the one **you crucified**.
- 5. What did the Holy Spirit accomplish (v.37)?
  - a. He led them to deep **conviction**.
  - b. He led them to **seek** a solution.
- 6. What did the listeners need to do (38-39)?
  - a. Seek **forgiveness** (remission of sin) because you are guilty.
  - b. Repent (**Turn around**).
  - c. **Believe** Faith is required.
  - d. Give public **evidence** of your repentance; be **baptized**.

Back to v.37. You have heard all of this. Do you believe it?
