Reformed theology does not recognize the church's unique position.

Reformed theology confused our Union with Christ with our communion with Christ-Notice John 15 and 1 John is not in our list of passages.

Reformed Theology does not recognize the Rapture as a unique event for the church-1 Thessalonians 4:16

Union with Christ occurs at the moment of believing the Gospel Union with Christ is permanent

The Baptism ministry of the Holy Spirit is the key ministry which places us in Christ. 1 Corinthians 12:13

Our Union with Christ is different than our communion with Christ.

The statement that **we are** *in* **Him** recalls the same expression in 2:5 ("by this we know that we are in Him") which John immediately links to *abiding* in Him (2:6). As we have seen, "abiding" is John's description of the experience of "living as a disciple" (cf. John 15:8). So the words **in Him** have a totally different meaning from Paul's concept of being "in Christ," but refer instead to the "abiding life" of obedience to God's commands.¹

Observation- John used the key word <u>abide</u> to describe the believers fellowship with God not the believer's union with God.

Colossians 2:10 (NKJV)

10 and you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power.
