- In the previous Lord's Days we were looking at the articles of the Apostles' Creed. What good is it to believe all this? A. 59 is beautiful.
- II. How does God see me and view me? What do I believe about this? How can I be sure of this?

## Knowing I Am Righteous

- I. The Justified Sinners
  - A. The true knowledge of justification is that we are at the same time justified and sinners. God justifies the ungodly (Rom. 4:5).
    - My conscience accuses me that I have transgressed all God's commands.
    - But God's Word points us to something that is as equally true: we are justified. What does this mean?
  - B. The truth of justification has beautiful application: We have a covenant relationship with God.
- II. The Alien Righteousness
  - A. We need alien righteousness because we have no righteousness of our own to bring. (A. 60, 61).
    Romans 4:1ff.
  - B. Our righteousness before God is God's righteousness that comes from Jesus Christ.

- III. The Means of Faith
  - A. Faith is the only means of our justification. I am justified by faith alone.
  - B. Let us embrace by faith alone that we are righteous before God for Jesus' sake.
