The Saved Must Depart From Sin

One thing is true, however, for those who are genuinely saved. Paul put it this way: *“let every one that nameth the name of Christ depart from iniquity.”* Some people claim that they are Christians, but they continue living in open or secret *“iniquity.”* According to this verse, saved people are commanded to *“depart from iniquity.”* God doesn't want to have any dealings with *“iniquity,”* He hates it. We who are saved should hate it also. Though we don't know who are the Lord's people, we are told *“by their fruits ye shall know them”* (Matthew 7:20). Obviously, if a person is picking pears, he's not picking them off of an apple tree. He is picking them off of a pear tree.
