One thing is true, however, for those who are genuinely saved. Paul put it this way: "*let every one that nameth the name of Christ depart from iniquity.*" Some people claim that they are Christians, but they continue living in open or secret "*iniquity.*" According to this verse, saved people are commanded to "*depart from iniquity.*" God doesn't want to have any dealings with "*iniquity.*" He hates it. We who are saved should hate it also. Though we don't know who are the Lord's people, we are told "*by their fruits ye shall know them*" (Matthew 7:20). Obviously, if a person is picking pears, he's not picking them off of an apple tree. He is picking them off of a pear tree.
