THE VARIOUS FORMS OF MODERN IDOLATRY HAVE ONE THING AT THEIR CORE: SELF.

THIS BRAND OF MODERN IDOLATRY TAKES VARIOUS FORMS:

1. WE WORSHIP AT THE ALTAR OF MATERIALISM WHICH FEEDS OUR NEED TO BUILD OUR EGOS THROUGH THE ACQUISITION OF MORE "STUFF."

2.WE WORSHIP AT THE ALTAR OF OUR OWN PRIDE AND EGO.

3.WE IDOLIZE MANKIND THROUGH NATURALISM AND THE POWER OF SCIENCE.

4.WE WORSHIP AT THE ALTAR OF SELF TO THE EXCLUSION OF ALL OTHERS AND THEIR NEEDS AND DESIRES.

C.PRIDE (14:8-14; 2 CHRO. 25:17-24).

PRIDE BLINDS THE MIND, DISTORTS THE VISION, AND  
SO INFLATES THE EGO THAT THE PERSON CAN'T  
TELL TRUTH FROM FICTION.

PRIDE IS AN ELEVATED VIEW OF AND A  
PREOCCUPATION WITH SELF.

PRIDE IS A FAULT WE DESPISE IN OTHERS YET  
FREELY EXCUSE AND EVEN JUSTIFY IN  
OURSELVES.

HOW, THEN, DOES ONE OVERCOME THE GRIEVOUS SIN OF PRIDE?

1. WE MUST UNDERSTAND THAT PRIDE, LIKE DANGEROUS NARCOTICS, IS ADDICTIVE AND DETRIMENTAL TO OUR WELL-BEING.

2. TO OVERCOME PRIDE, WE MUST REMEMBER, AS THE PSALMIST DID, OUR CONDITION BEFORE CHRIST'S SALVATION:
