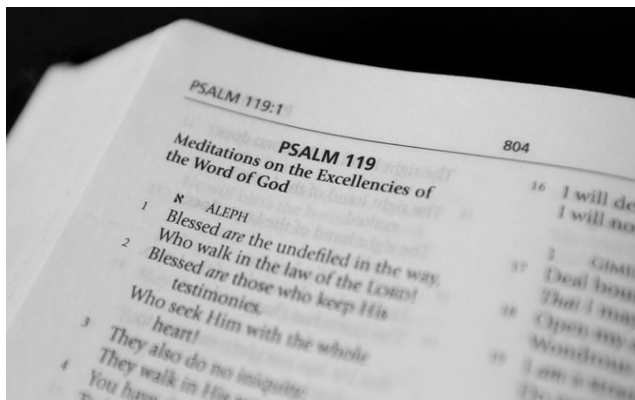


## “Increasing Our Love For God’s Word”

- Longest Psalm
- Unknown Author; thought to be David, Ezra, Daniel, or Jeremiah
- “Real life” Psalm
- Theme that shines through: the all-sufficiency of God’s Word

- **Affliction** vs. 67, 71, 107
  - Definitions: pain or suffering; an ‘uprooting’ of life
  - We all experience affliction to some extent – how will you respond?
- **Obedience** vs. 56
  - A life-long practice
  - What are you practicing?
- **End Well** vs. 112
  - No one knows when their end will be or when Jesus will come back
  - Obedience takes resolve
- **Scripture As A Guide** vs. 105, 89
  - Illuminates our path
  - Have to learn and know it in order to live it
- **How Are You Doing?** Vs. 59-60
  - Self-evaluation
  - Course Correction
  - Move forward in Christ
- **Results of Living Like This** vs. 1-3
  - Happy and blessed
  - Lives not mired in distraction and sin
