Q. 122. Which is the first petition?

in all Your works, in which Your power, wisdom, goodness, justice, mercy and truth,
are clearly displayed;
and further, that we may so order and direct our whole lives, our thoughts, words and actions,
that Your name may never be blasphemed, but rather honored and praised on our account.
