
Psalm 23 (Part 4)

* God's Sheep Shall Not Lack Provision!


* HIS PROVISION IS GENEROUS (v. 5-6)

(What God <u>gives us</u> should be fulfilling)
Our Shepherd meets our need for provisions, because He is our Giver.

I. GOD'S GIVING MAKES US FEEL <u>IMPORTANT</u>

"Table . . . in the presence of mine enemies"

II. GOD'S GIVING MAKES US FEEL REFRESHED
"Anointest my head with oil"



III. GOD'S GIVING MAKES US FEEL SATISFIED

"My cup runneth over"

IV. GOD'S GIVING MAKES US FEEL <u>SECURE</u> (v.6)

"Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever.""
