Two Commands

Do not be drunk with wine

(Proverbs 23:31-35; 1 Thessalonians 5:6-8; Romans 13:12-13)

Drunkenness is sin; never go there.

Be filled with the Spirit

“Under the influence of the Spirit we do not lose self-control, we gain it.” JRW Stott

So, how can we be filled with the Holy Spirit? Or, yield to Him?

Paul gives 5 ways that we are filled with the Holy Spirit:

1) Speaking in hymns 2) Singing 3) Making music 4) Thanking 5) Submitting

Speaking to Each Other with Music

We sing to glorify God and to edify our brothers and sisters in Christ.

One of your primary jobs in worship is singing, and making music.

Speaking to God in Song

God has placed a song in the heart of every believer.

Thanking God in the Name of Jesus.

Gratitude overflows in song.

Submitting to Each Other

As we reverence Christ, we submit to each other.

We are all under submission.
