Nehemiah, part 2: "Grace in the Moment" Nehemiah 2:1-8

God's servant prays, and God answers!

1. Prevailing Prayer – and God's Answer

(1) Nehemiah had been praying for four months!

"And it came to pass in the month of Nisan..."

vv. 1-3

-1- Praying for the spiritual recovery of the nation $~(cf.~1:\!4ff.)$

-2- Praying very specifically!

-3- Praying for an opening to appeal to the king. (cf. 1:11)

(2) Nehemiah makes petition before the king (5-6a)

-1- The Background: 4 months of prayer! 4 months of careful thought!

- The petitions Nehemiah brings before the king are undoubtedly those he *already* brought before the King of Kings!
- -2- The Petitions: Big and Bold! Very Specific!
 [1] To go to Jerusalem and rebuild it.

 Thus, to have *royal authority* to do so
 Nehemiah to be the governor of the region

 [2] A specific and extended time to undertake this great work
 [3] Safe passage

[4] Full provision for building!

(3) God answers! Wonderfully so!

(2) The opening comes for which Nehemiah had prayed – but in an unexpected way!

- A danger looms! "I took the wine and gave it to the king. Now I had never been sad in his presence before."
- The king might well suspect "Why is your face sad, since you are not sick?

Why is your face sad, since you are not sick? This is nothing but sorrow of heart.' So I became dreadfully afraid."

- Nehemiah shares the burden of his heart. v. 3

something subversive!

(3) God answers!

"Then the king said to me, 'What do you request?'

2. Momentary Prayer – And God's Answer

vv. 4b-8

"So I prayed to the God of heaven."

(1) Nehemiah cries out to God!

- Praying for wisdom in expression and request!

- Praying for a favorable response!
