- 1. What details in Chapter 11 point once again to God being the driving force behind Israel's victory?
- 2. Why is the destruction of the horses and chariots especially important to the mission of the Israelites?
- 3. Discuss the process of the Lord hardening the hearts of the Canaanites. What purpose did it serve? How are the kings still responsible for their actions?
- 4. How does the inclusion of the expulsion of the Anakim from the hill country (vv.21-22) tie both earlier and later events in Israelite history together?
- 5. In v. 23, the land has rest from war. How is "rest" used in Scripture? How tenuous is this rest? What ultimate rest do we look to in the future?
