1. Rejoice always.

2. Pray without ceasing.

4. Do not quench the Spirit.

5. Do not despise prophecies.

1 Corinthians 14:1–3 (ESV)

Pursue love, and earnestly desire the spiritual gifts, especially that you may prophesy. ² For one who speaks in a tongue speaks not to men but to God; for no one understands him, but he utters mysteries in the Spirit.

³ On the other hand, the one who prophesies speaks to people for their upbuilding and encouragement and consolation.

1 Corinthians 14:37–38 (ESV) – *If anyone thinks that he is a prophet, or spiritual, he should acknowledge that the things I am writing to you are a command of the Lord.*

³⁸ If anyone does not recognize this, he is not recognized.

1 Corinthians 14:29 (ESV) - *Let two or three prophets speak, and let the others weigh what is said.*

5. Do not despise prophecies.

- a. Cling tightly to what is good.
- b. Abstain from every form of evil.
