Consider & Discuss (Be Transformed!)

- What does "according to" indicate in verse 4 and 5?
- Who are these people who Paul says, "walk according to the flesh" (4) and "are according to the flesh" (5)?
- Who are these people who Paul says walk "according to the Spirit" and "are according to the Spirit" (5)?
- What are "the things of the flesh"? and "the things of the Spirit" (5)?
- In verse 6 Paul says "the mind... is death" and "the mind... is life and peace." What do these phrases mean? See verse 7-8.
- In verse 9 Paul shifts from a general discussion of the result of God sending Jesus with a focus on those who remain in the flesh, to a focus on "you" who are in the Spirit. What does Paul indicate is the result in you and your life of God sending Jesus?
- Based on verse 9, how would you describe the human need for the indwelling Spirit of Christ?
- What does verse 11 indicate the role of the Holy Spirit to be in bringing about these results?
- How does knowing these things about those who "are according to the flesh" inform you and your life?
- How does knowing these things about those who "are according to the Spirit" inform you and your life?
- How do you know if the Spirit of God dwells in you?
