"That Your Joy May Be Full!" John 15:11

Introduction:

- 1. I Know That The First Verse On Your Message Guide:
 - Is In The Gospel Of John:
 - But Tonight I Would Like For Us To Begin:
 - Back Where We Were This Morning:
 - In The Book Of 2 Corinthians!
 - So Please Turn In Your Bibles With Me:
 - To 2 Corinthians 2:3 Where Paul Wrote "And I wrote this same unto you, lest, when I came, I should have sorrow from them of whom I ought to rejoice; having confidence in you all, that my joy is the joy of you all!"
 - As I Was Preparing For The Message This Morning:
 - The Last Phrase Of Verse 3 Jumped Out At Me!
 - "My Joy Is The Joy Of You All!"
 - One Of Paul's Desires For The Corinthian Church:
 - Was For Them All To Experience:
 - Joy!
 - True Joy!
 - Even His Joy!
- 2. In Other Words:
 - What Gave Paul Joy:
 - Would Also Give Them Joy!
 - So The Question Comes To Mind:
 - What Gives Paul Joy?
 - What Makes Him Genuinely Happy As A Christian?
 - When You Look At The Rest Of:
 - Paul's Letters You Discover:
 - That The Things That Brought Paul Joy:
 - Were Primarily Spiritual Things:
 - Rather Than Physical / Material / Or Even Personal Things!
 - For Example In Philippians 2:2 Paul Wrote:
 - "Fulfil ye my joy, that ye be likeminded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind!"
 - This Kind Of Christian Fellowship Is What Gave Paul Great Joy!
- 3. **IE:** So Often We Have It The Other Way Around, Don't We? We Try To Find Happiness In People & Places & Things!
 - But Ultimately The Things That Gave Paul Joy:
 - Were The Same Things That Brings God Joy!
 - And So What Paul Said About His Own Joy Can Be Applied To The Lord As Well!
 - "My Joy Is The Joy Of You All!"
 - And This Is What I Want To Focus Our Attention On Tonight!
- 4. And So Now, Let's Head Over To:
 - John 15:11 "These things have I spoken unto you, that my joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full!"
 - Do You Realize That Jesus:
 - Wants You To Be Joyful:
 - In Your Life As A Christian?
 - With Real Joy!
 - With His Joy!
 - With Full Joy!
 - And Yet How Many Of Us:
 - Can Honestly Say That We Are Living Our Lives:
 - With This Kind Of Joy?
 - Instead, We Often Struggle Through Life With Sadness, Discouragement, And Sometimes Even Despair!
 - And So We Wonder "Where Is This Joy?"

- Where Is This Joy That Jesus Was Speaking Of?
- Well As We Apply The Words Of Paul:
 - To The Joy Of Jesus:
 - I Think We Can Find Our Answer!
 - "My Joy Is The Joy Of You All!"
 - That Is That Which Brings Joy To Christ Will Bring Joy To Christians!
- 5. And In The Context Of John 15:
 - Jesus Explains To Us What Brings Him Joy!
- * The First Thing We See Is That:
- 1. Faith In The Lord Brings Joy!
 - 15:1-3 "I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman. / Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: and every branch that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit. / Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you!"
 - This Is Where True Joy Must Start!
 - In A Personal Relationship With The Lord:
 - Through Faith In Him & His Word!
 - Just Look At What God's Word:
 - Can Do For Lost Sinners Like You & Like Me!
 - 15:3 "Now Ye Are Clean!"
 - This Is What Happens When You "Believe On The Lord Jesus Christ" And Are Saved!
 - Paul Tells Us In:
 - Ephesians 5:25-27 That "Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; / That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, / That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish!"
 - Doesn't This Truth:
 - Give You Joy:
 - If You Are A Christian Today?
 - Doesn't This Truth Make You:
 - Genuinely Happy?
 - "The Blood Of Jesus Christ" Has:
 - Cleansed You From "All Sin!" (1 John 1:7)
 - When You Trust In The Lord:
 - He Forgives You:
 - Of All Of Your Trespasses & Sins Against Him!
 - He Also Frees You:
 - From The Bondage Of Your Own Will & Sin!
 - And Doesn't The Lord Himself:
 - Experience Joy:
 - When A Sinner Is Saved?
 - In Luke 15:7 Jesus Himself Said "I say unto you, that likewise joy shall be in heaven over one sinner that repenteth, more than over ninety and nine just persons, which need no repentance!"
 - Remember:
 - That Which Brings Joy To Christ Will Bring Joy To Christians!
 - Faith In The Lord:
 - Will Bring You Joy!
 - Real Joy!
 - Full Joy!
 - Lasting Joy!
- * Second Back In John 15 We See:
- 2. Fellowship With The Lord Brings Joy!
 - 15:4-7 "Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me. / I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing. / If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned. / If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you!"

- This Is How True Joy Can Continue:
 - In The Life Of A Christian!
 - Through Fellowship With The Lord!
 - And "Abiding" In Him!
- **IE:** Throughout His Ministry, Jesus Christ Used Natural Objects To Illustrate Spiritual Truths He Uses The Figure Of A Grape Vine To Illustrate The Relationship Between Him & His People!
 - And Just As A "Branch" Is Connected To Its "Vine":
 - Christians Are To "Abide" In Christ!
 - And Remain In Fellowship With Him!
 - How Do We Do That?
 - Express Your Trust In & Dependance Upon The Lord Every Single Day!
- You Can Have Fellowship With The Lord:
 - When You Receive His Word!
 - When 15:7 His "Words Abide In You!"
 - You Will Never Be Able To Experience The Fulness Of The Lord's Joy:
 - Apart From The Word Of God!
 - May You Experience What Jeremiah Experienced:
 - In Jeremiah 15:16 "Thy words were found, and I did eat them; and thy word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart: for I am called by thy name, O LORD God of hosts!"
- You Can Have Fellowship With The Lord:
 - When You Request His Will!
 - Through Prayer 15:7 "If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you!"
- And Doesn't The Lord Himself:
 - Experience Joy:
 - When There Is This Kind Of Fellowship
 - With His People?
 - In John 17:20-21 Jesus Prays "For them also which shall believe on me through their word; / That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me!"
 - Jesus Prayed That There Would Be A Special & Sweet Kind Of Fellowship:
 - With His People!
 - And This Kind Of Fellowship Undoubtedly Brings Him Joy!
- So When You Find Yourself Struggling With The Joy Of The Lord In Your Heart Remember:
 - That Which Brings Joy To Christ Will Bring Joy To Christians!
 - Fellowship With The Lord:
 - Will Bring You Joy!
 - Real Joy!
 - Full Joy!
 - Lasting Joy!

- * We Also See That:
- 3. Faithfulness To The Lord Brings Joy!
 - 15:8-17 "Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples. / As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you: continue ye in my love. / If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love. / These things have I spoken unto you, that my joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full. / This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you. / Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. / Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you. / Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto you. / Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you. / These things I command you, that ye love one another!"
 - Jesus Wants His People:
 - To Be Joyful People!
 - And One Of The Keys To This Joy:
 - Is Faithfulness & Obedience To The Word Of God!

- In 3 John 1:4 John Wrote:
 - "I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth!"
 - Is John Just Speaking For Himself?
 - Or Is He Not Also Speaking:
 - On Behalf Of The Lord Himself!
 - Even Proverbs 23:24 Tells Us That "The father of the righteous shall greatly rejoice: and he that begetteth a wise child shall have joy of him!"
 - When The Children Of The Lord:
 - Walk In His Truth:
 - It Brings Joy To The Lord & To Our Father In Heaven!
- One Of The Reasons Why So Many Christians:
 - Have Lost The Joy Of The Lord:
 - Is Because They Have Forgotten:
 - This Simple Truth!
 - That "There Is Happiness In Holiness!"
 - However The Pull Of The World:
 - To Sin Is Still So Strong Isn't It?
 - John Describes It As "All that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life!"
 - The World May Promise:
 - Some Level Of Excitement & Pleasure!
 - But We Must Never Forget That The "Pleasures Of Sin" Will Only Last "For A Season!" (Hebrews 11:25)
- So Remember:
 - That Which Brings Joy To Christ Will Bring Joy To Christians!
 - Faithfulness To The Lord:
 - Will Bring You Joy!
 - Real Joy!
 - Full Joy!
 - Lasting Joy!
- * Another Thing That Will Bring You Joy Is Fruitfulness!
- 4. Fruitfulness To The Lord Brings Joy!
 - All Throughout John 15:
 - Jesus Talks About Fruitfulness!
 - 15:2 "Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: and every branch that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit!"
 - 15:5 "I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing!"
 - 15:16 "Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you!"
 - A Fruitful Christian:
 - Brings Great Joy To The Lord!
 - 15:8 "Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples!"
 - The Lord Wants His Children To Grow!
 - The Lord Enjoys It When His Children Grow!
 - And So The Lord Has Provided All That We Need In Order To Grow!
 - 2 Peter 1:3 Tells Us That He -"Hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness!"
 - So Keep Growing As A Christian!
 - Keep Bearing The Fruit:
 - That Is Cultivated Through The Work & Power Of The Holy Spirit!
 - Galatians 5:22-23 "The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, / Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law!"
 - And This Fruit & Your Growth
 - Will Bring Joy & Glory To The Lord!
 - In The Old Testament Book Of Haggai:

- It Was Time For The People Of God:
 - To Rebuild The Temple In Jerusalem!
 - But Instead They Dwelled In Their "Cieled & Paneled Houses!"
 - But Because The House Of God "Lied In Waste" They Did Not Experience Any True & Lasting Joy!
- But Listen To What The Lord Told Them:
 - Haggai 1:8 "Go up to the mountain, and bring wood, and build the house; and I will take pleasure in it, and I will be glorified, saith the LORD!"
 - The Lord Continues To Delight Himself & Take Pleasure In The "Building" Up Of His House Which Is His People!
 - So Keep Growing! Keep Bearing His Fruit! Keep "Growing in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ!" (2 Peter 3:18)
- And Remember:
 - That Which Brings Joy To Christ Will Bring Joy To Christians!
 - Growth & Fruitfulness In The Lord:
 - Will Bring You Joy!
 - Real Joy!
 - Full Joy!
 - Lasting Joy!

Conclusion:

- Do You Long For This Kind Of Joy?
 - Then Think About What Brings Joy:
 - To The Lord!
 - Because His Joy Is Your Joy!
 - What Brings Him Joy:
 - Is What Will Bring You Joy!
 - And Don't Settle:
 - For Anything Less!
