Sermon Series: Daniel: Christ Among the Exiles

Sermon Text: Daniel 7:13-18 The Son of Man Over the Beasts

In Christ we have the hope of everlasting and global dominion.

1) Christ Jesus became man to recover man.

- a) "with the clouds of heaven" indicates deity
- b) "one like a son of man" (v. 13) interpreted as "saints of the Most High" (v. 18)
- c) Christ as representative, covenant head of His people
- d) Identity in Christ is holy (saints)
- e) **Application**: Are you finding your identity in Christ?

2) Christ Jesus became man to recover man's dominion.

- a) "to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom"—implies reward for work; entrusted due to faithful service
- b) "that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him"—rescued from beast-empires (v. 17 "four beasts are four kings")
- c) "But the saints of the Most High shall receive the kingdom"—receive as a gift
- d) "possess the kingdom forever"—security of dominion
- e) Application: How do we exercise dominion now?
 - i) In Christ, not in the flesh/old Adam
 - ii) In our worship of Christ
 - iii) In our witness for Christ
 - iv) In obedience to Christ in our various callings
 - v) Believing the truth God has revealed (v. 16)
