#### Matthew 6:9-13

After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. <sup>10</sup> Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as *it is* in heaven. <sup>11</sup> Give us this day our daily bread. <sup>12</sup> And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. <sup>13</sup> And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.

#### Matthew 6:5-8

And when thou prayest, thou shalt not be as the hypocrites *are*: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward. <sup>6</sup> But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly. <sup>7</sup> But when ye pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen *do*: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking. <sup>8</sup> Be not ye therefore like unto them: for your Father knoweth what things ye have need of, before ye ask him.

#### Luke 11:1

And it came to pass, that, as he was praying in a certain place, when he ceased, one of his disciples said unto him, Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples.

#### John 17:1

These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee:

### John 17:4

I have glorified thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do.

### John 17:17-18

Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth. <sup>18</sup> As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world.

### Hebrews 7:25

Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.

### 1. Our prayer should be personal:

Luke 11:2b ... Our Father which art in heaven...

### 2. Our prayer should be worshipful:

Luke 11:2c ... Hallowed be thy name...

### 3. Our prayer should seek the will of God:

Luke 11:2c ... Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth.

## 4. Our prayer should include seeking His provision:

Luke 11:3 Give us day by day our daily bread.

### Luke 12:24

Consider the ravens: for they neither sow nor reap; which neither have storehouse nor barn; and God feedeth them: how much more are ye better than the fowls?

# 5. Our prayer should include seeking forgiveness:

Luke 11:4a And forgive us our sins...

# 6. Our prayer should include asking for help forgiving:

Luke 11:4b ... for we also forgive every one that is indebted to us...

### Ephesians 4:32

And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

# 7. Our prayer should include asking for help avoiding sin:

Luke 11:4c ... And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil.
