1. Phil 4:4-9 - 1:27 = thesis statement: whatever happens, live gospel-defined life as citizen of heaven, united to Jesus & to one another in X - 2:1-5.

1st: Paul's Joy

- 1. Paul's joy: major motif; 16x in 4 chpts. Paul imprisoned w/ joy.
- 2. <u>1:4</u> prays for brethren; <u>1:18</u> that gospel is being preached; <u>2:17-18</u> while suffering for Christ [Mt 5:10-12]
- 3. sees Xns in light of Jesus' return 3:20-4:1 [1Thes 2:19-20; Phil 1:6; 2C 5:7].
- 4. <u>4:10</u> fellowship: v17-20

2nd: The Philippian's Joy

- 1. <u>2:18</u> share joy in Christ; <u>2:1-2</u> Xn fellowship in Christ w/ actual people: Tim [2:19]; Paul 2:24]; Epaphroditus <u>2:28-30</u>
 - i. Realize the kingdom-significance of our relationships
 - ii. Paul's concern for Cors [2C7:6]: *depressed*. God *comforted* [2x]: how? Titus w/ good report of Cor [2C7:7]
 - iii. We are each responsible to encourage one another's joy.
- 2. 1:25 growth in grace & knowledge of truth -> experience of joy
- 3. 4:4 Christian joy is *in the Ld*.

3rd: Let Us Rejoice in the Lord, with the Lord, Together at the Lord's Table

- 1. Repent a "killjoy" is "a person who makes other people less happy, excited or enthusiastic about some event or thing."
- 2. Ask self questions re: how you impact others.
- 3. At LT, ask Jesus to invigorate your kingdom-joy: in Him.
