- 7. How is the fourfold cycle from this book evident in Ruth, chapter 1?
- 8. What part of the cycle is always emphasized in Judges?
- 9. How is this evident also in Ruth?
- 10. Who is the main character of chapter 2?
- 11. What is the focus of chapter 2? (2:11,12)
- 12. How does this parallel the focus of chapter 1? (1:16)
- 13. How does Boaz reflect Jesus in this chapter?
- 14. How should we be like Ruth? (2:11,12; 1:16)
- 15. How was Ruth like Abraham? (2:11; see Gen.12;1f)
- 16. How should we be like Boaz? (2:1f,4f,8f,14f)
