- 1. The seeker's right approach verse 17
 - a. He came in the right way urgently
 - **b.** He came with the right attitude **humbly**
 - **c.** He came to the right person **deity**
 - **d.** He came for the right reason **eternity**
 - e. He came at the right time **presently**
- 2. The seeker's wrong assumptions verse 17
 - **a.** He assumed Jesus was a good teacher but **not God.**
 - b. He assumed there was a good work he could do to **inherit** eternal life.
- 3. Jesus' revealing response verse 18-20
 - a. Don't be mistaken about the **person** of the Savior (verse 18) Jesus is not merely good; he is God.
 - b. Don't be confused about the **problem** of sin (verse 19-20) The law is not the answer; it is the problem
- 4. The seeker's foolish rejection. Verse 21-22
 - **a.** He assumed he could come to Jesus **on his own terms.**
 - b. He assumed that earthly possessions were of more value than **eternal life**.
