 And He called His twelve disciples to Himself and gave them authority over unclean spirits, so as to cast them out, and to heal every disease and every ailment. As a gift, you received; as a gift, give. 9 "Do not acquire gold nor silver nor copper for your <i>money</i> -belts, 10 "do not acquire a knapsack for the way, nor two tunics nor sandals nor a staff; for the worker is worthy of his nourishment. 11 "But into whichever city or village you enter, research who in it is worthy, and remain there until whenever you come out. 12 "And, when <i>you</i> enter into the house, greet it; 13 "and, on the one hand, if the house is worthy, let your 'Peace' come upon it; on the other, if it is not worthy, let your 'Peace' return to you. 14 "And whoever does not accept you nor hear your words, when you go out of the house or out of that city, shake off the dust from your feet. 15 "Amen, I say to you, it will be more bearable for the land of Sodom and Gomorrah in the day of judgment than for that city!"
