- I. Although it is true that all of life for the Christian is worship, it is also true that God has given special, regular times of corporate worship.
- II. God's law provides the boundaries for how we worship Him.

Worship Pleasing to God

I. God-Glorifying

- A. In our corporate worship we experience the highest form of covenant fellowship with God.
 - 1. Worship is the meeting of the church in a covenant assembly before the face of God to praise and thank Him for all that He has done.
 - 2. Worship is covenant conversation.

II. Regulated

A. The 2nd commandment teaches the regulative principle of worship.

- 1. First, God says no images.
