

# Grace of God Appearing

*TITUS 2:11-14*

**Topic:** The Grace of God

**Theme:** What the Grace of God has done, will do, is doing, and why

**Main Idea:** The Grace of God came to teach us how to live a life zealous for good works.

**Application:** That The Lost would Be saved, and Christians would be better equipped to interpret their life experience and pursue a lifestyle fitting sound doctrine and zealous for good works.
