

- I. Unity is an essential blessing
 - A. Unity in Scripture (Genesis 2:21, 24; 1 Kings 12; Numbers 16; 2 Samuel 20; Leviticus 26:33; Matthew 12:25)
 - B. The divided heart (1 Kings 18:21; Mark 7:6 cf. Isaiah 29:13; Matthew 6:24; 1 Timothy 3:8)
 - C. Unite my heart! (Psalm 86:11-12)

- II. Unity in holiness is preparation for reunion with Christ.
 - A. Jesus wants us to be one in preparation for meeting him again (Song 3:1-2; John 20:15; Isaiah 25:9)
 - B. Why “reunion”?

- III. Unity in holiness is rooted in the unity of God
 - A. Flowing from the unity of God
 - B. Moving toward the unity of God

- IV. Unity in holiness is also unity in love
 - A. Holiness “from” can lead us to divide
 - B. Jesus’ holiness led him to love (Luke 1:17)
