## **The Beginning of Covenant Grace**

Genesis 12:1-8

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## Genesis breaks into two parts.

- God Sovereignty in his **<u>creative works</u>** Creation and foundational history 1-11
- God's Sovereignty in his **redemptive work** Generations and foundational promises 12-50
- 1. God **conceived** the Covenant of Grace.
  - a. God's covenant depended on His **foreknowledge** Eph 1:3-4
  - b. God's covenant was based on His **promise**. 12:1-3
    - i. A **land promise** for perpetuity 12:1
    - ii. A promise of **national** status 12:1
    - iii. A promise of a great **name** 12:2
    - iv. A promise of be a **conduit** of blessings. 12:2
    - v. A promise of **associational** blessing 12:3 (2 part)
    - vi. A promise of **universal** blessing 12:3
- 2. Abraham **received** the covenant of Grace. 12:1; 15:7
  - a. He heard God's voice while **still a pagan**. 11:31-32; Heb 11:8
  - b. He believed God's **promise** of a better country– Gen 12:4
  - c. He received God's covenant by grace without **personal effort**. 15:1-6
- 3. We can **inherit** the Covenant of Grace by faith. 12:3
  - a. This covenant of grace is for **everyone**.
  - b. This covenant only comes to you by **grace through faith**. Gal 3:26 -29
  - c. The covenant is made by God, maintained by God and guaranteed by God yet it still must be **received by faith**.
    - i. We must receive this covenant **personally**. Eph 1:13-14
    - ii. We must accept this covenant as a **gift**. Eph 2:8-9

Faith acts on the promise of God's grace. Have you acted?
