Jesus Welcomes the Destitute: He Offers Them Mercy

How does God offer his mercy?

- 1. Mercy is **<u>dispensed</u>** at divine appointments verse 46
 - a. God knows our condition
 - b. God controls our circumstances
 - c. God cares about individuals
- 2. Mercy is **discovered** when we desperately call (verses 47-48)
 - a. Cry out passionately
 - b. Cry out personally
 - c. Cry out persistently
- 3. Mercy is **<u>delivered</u>** when we answer God's call (verses 49-51)
 - a. Jesus hears the cry of faith He stood still
 - b. Jesus calls for **responsive faith** (Mark 1:15) Tell him to come to me!
 - c. Jesus sees our **<u>steps of faith</u>** verse 50 He threw off his beggar's cloak.
 - d. Jesus questions the **focus of faith** verse 51 What do you want?
 - e. Jesus rewards our **<u>simple faith</u>** verse 52
 - i. He believed
 - ii. He received
 - iii. He <u>followed</u>

Jesus offers more than health; he offers **wholeness**. He offers more than riches; he offers **restoration**. He offers more than a living; He offers **life**.
