Introduction

- I. Jesus' ascension was an advancement in glory and exaltation (as Son of God in our flesh).
- II. Christ was taken up from earth into heaven and continues there for our interest.

Our Ascended Advocate

I. The Amazing Gift

A. In I John 2:1, Jesus is identified as "an advocate with the Father."

- B. Application: we can then pray to our heavenly Father in the assurance that He hears.
- II. The Future Hope
 - A. Christ's ascension into heaven is a sure pledge that He will take us to Himself.

B. This hope we have is certain (Hebrews 6).

- **III. The Earthly Presence**
 - A. Although He is in heaven, He is also with us.
 - B. What a comfort this is to know Christ has not abandoned us, but is present with us.
