Review: Gospel Main theme = <u>Jesus</u>

7 Sub-themes = <u>Ascension</u> / <u>Identification</u>

Exalted at the right hand of God

Therefore: Connects 2:32-33 Exalted: to elevate or lift up

When was Jesus exalted? How high was He exalted?

The right hand of God

What it <u>doesn't</u> mean: What it does mean:

He poured out this

What Jesus received from the Father following His Ascension

The Promise of the Holy Spirit: Luke 24:49 / Acts 1:4-5

What does it mean that Jesus received the Promise?

Compare Joel 2:27-28

This that you yourselves are seeing & hearing

The Lord said to my Lord

David did not ascend into the heavens

But he himself says... Psalm 110:1

Sit at my right hand: Implied You / My

Luke 22:69 - "From now on..."

Until I make your enemies your footstool

Enemies:

2 Thessalonians 1:4-10

Until: 1 Corinthians 15:22-28

Footstool:

God has made Him both Lord and Christ

Let Israel know for certain

God revealed certain proof to Israel:

Lord: Philippians 2:9-11

Christ: Messiah

Application For Today

Acknowledge: that Jesus is exalted at God's Right Hand in Heaven now

Honor: Jesus as the One Who poured out His Spirit upon you

Trust: that all of Christ's enemies will be subjugated under His feet

Know: with absolute certainty that Jesus is both Lord and Christ
