### INTRODUCTION

- 1. For what are you thankful? Hope.
- 2. "Well, it depends... I hope so... but..." Christian hope is a certainty.

#### 1st: Those Outside Christ Have No Hope

- 1. Eph 2:11-13 focus: v12 experiential: remember? => former experience
  - i. separate from Christ formerly v2 & v3. Remember being ruled by lust, not living under reign of Christ?
  - ii. excluded from the commonwealth of Israel separate & excluded = realm of death, w/o the living God
    - a. commonwealth = citizen in nation: theocracy God's gov't
    - b. Gentiles given dif/ levels of integration into OCov nation, but as Gentiles, they were χιτιζενσ of nations governed by demonic idols.
    - c. Rm 9:3-5 blessings of Israel according to the flesh. Note: to be separate from Christ is to be accursed anathema; also the covs
  - iii. strangers to covs of promise: AbCov; OCov; DavCov; Jer 31:31-34.
  - iv. having no hope Vulgate: having no hope of the promise [Gn 3:15].
    - a. w/o promises -> hopelessness.
    - b. Hope is determined by the trustworthiness of the Promiser.
  - v. w/o God no exeriential relationship; no fear of God Eph 4:17-19.
    - a. *a depraved mind* [Rom 1:25, 28].
    - b. Knowledge of God engages entire humanity not knowledge from creation & conscience [Rm 1:20], but saving knowledge Jn 17:3
    - c. w/o God yet image of God inevitable: idolatry [Athenians A 17 & Babylonians Hab 1:11]. Men become like what they worship Hab 2:18 an idol is a teacher of falsehood will idolaters believe in lies & tell lies?
  - vi. in the world cosmos: original creation: good but fallen; common curse sustained by common grace Ps 17:14-15 this world, this life.
    - a. portion => inheritance, allotment creation's "goods"
    - 1b. this world this life boundary of hope: cursed w/ death
- 2. Heb 2:14-15 Devil's power of death enslave thru fear of death all life
  - i. this life is experienced as fearing death the fear & death: miserable
  - ii. The condition of flesh & blood all men: slavery to the fear of death.
- 3. How is Satan's power of death exerted on men?
  - i. Satan a tempter: entices to sin: obtain a "good" by breaking law. Adam
  - ii. Satan is accuser: indicts as guilty before the bar of God. Job.
  - iii. Conscience echoes Devil's indictments -> distracts from fear of death.
- 4. Death becomes the defining point of reference for living. Vanity: Solomon.
- 5. Frantic grasping after what is passing away. Discipleship Lk 17:33.
- Fear of death coersive intimidation.

#### 2nd: We in Christ Have Hope

- 1. 1Pt 3:14-16 v14 not fear their fear [same term]; troubled: panicked. Isa 8:12-13; Mt 10:28. Overcome fear of men's anger w/ fear of God's anger.
  - i. Note: suffer for sake of righteousness Lk 6:22
  - ii. Xn exposes the hopelessness angers v16.
- 2. Do 4 thgs: 1st v14 suffer & do not fear; 2nd v15,16 tend to inner man:

- a. sanctify Christ as Lord heart = worship
- -0b. keep a good conscience integrity Rm 12:1-2

**3rd**] v16 - *good behavior* - Tit 2:11-14.

- 3. Your good behavior could incite curiosity 4th] be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks. Explain why you have hope.
  - i. an account: a message communicate words
  - ii. the hope that is in you YOUR experiential religion Col 1:27; your faith [Hb 11:1] faith, hope, love: essence of experiential religion speak about the One you trust; His promises & why you hope in Him.
  - iii. yet w/ gentleness & reverence but [contrast w/ anger of intimidation]
    - a. gentleness "a quality of friendliness"; accommodate to weakness
    - b. reverence fear = respect; realize what person is facing: w/o hope
- 04. Final judgment: will be put to shame: defeat; discover you've relied on a lie.

# Applic #1: Do Not Live With Misplaced Hope

- 1. <u>1Pt 3:14-16</u>
- 2. Misplaced hope contained w/i this life, this world. We want to overcome fear w/ hope, but do not settle for misplaced hope.
- 3. <u>1Pt 1:13</u> *completely* final hope <u>v8</u>. Be thankful for hope!
