

PSALM 112

v. 1 – (You [p.]) praise Yah / Hallelu Yah, (2 words – הִלְלוּ יְהוָה)

Blessed (is) the afraid of Yahweh man, (5 words – אִישׁ יִרָא אֶת - יְהוָה)
in His commandments he delighted exceedingly. (3 words – בְּמִצְוֹתָיו חִפְּץ מְאֹד)

v. 2 – Mighty in the land will be his seed, (4 words – גִּבּוֹר בְּאֶרֶץ יְהוָה זֵרְעוֹ)
the generation of the upright ones will be blessed. (3 words – דֹּרֹת יְשָׁרִים יְבָרְךְ)

v. 3 – Wealth and riches (are) in his house, (3 words – הוֹן - וְעֶשֶׂר בְּבֵיתוֹ)
and his righteousness is standing forever. (3 words – וְצִדְקָתוֹ עֹמְדַת לְעַד)

v. 4 – A light arose in the darkness for the upright ones, (4 words – זָרַח בַּחֹשֶׁךְ אֹר לְיְשָׁרִים)
gracious and compassionate and righteous. (3 words – תְּנוּן וְרַחוּם וְצַדִּיק)

v. 5 – Good is the man who is showing favor and who is lending, (3 words – טוֹב - אִישׁ חוֹנֵן וּמְלוֹה)
he will manage his things with justice. (3 words – יִכְלֹל דְּבָרָיו בְּמִשְׁפָּט)

v. 6 – For forever he will not be shaken, (4 words – כִּי - לְעוֹלָם לֹא - יִמוּט)
for a remembrance forever, a righteous man will be. (4 words – לְזִכָּר עוֹלָם יְהוָה צַדִּיק)

v. 7 – From evil reports he will not fear, (4 words – מִשְׁמוּעָה רָעָה לֹא יִירָא)
his heart is being steadfast, while trusting in Yahweh. (4 words – לִבּוֹ לִבּוֹ בִטָּח בִּיהוָה)

v. 8 – While his heart is being unshakable, he will not fear, (4 words – סָמוּךְ לִבּוֹ לֹא יִירָא)
until which he will see against his adversaries. (4 words – לְעַד אֲשֶׁר - יִרְאֶה בְּצָרָיו)

v. 9 – He has dispersed, he has given to the poor, (3 words – פָּזַר נָתַן לְאֲבִיוֹנִים)
his righteousness is standing forever, (3 words – וְצִדְקָתוֹ עֹמְדַת לְעַד)
his horn will be exalted in honor. (3 words – קַרְנוֹ תָרוּם בְּכָבוֹד)

Compare v. 3

v. 10 – A wicked man will see and be angry, (3 words – רָשָׁע יִרְאֶה וְכָעַס)
his teeth he will gnash and he will melt away, (3 words – לְשׁוֹנוֹ יִחַרַק וְנָמַס)
the desire of the wicked ones will perish. (3 words – תַּאֲוַת רָשָׁעִים תֵּאבֵד)
