## **Introduction:**

In these verses, we are given a preview of Armageddon and the final reaping of the earth at the coming of Christ. It is pictured as a great harvest.

## **Two Harvests:**

1. Harvest of \_\_\_\_\_ - depicted in John 4:35 as a harvest of souls who come to know Christ as Savior
2. Harvest of \_\_\_\_\_ - depicted in Revelation 14 which consists of the harvest of the unsaved at the end of the Tribulation Period.

### **I. THE \_\_\_\_\_ (14:14-16)**

#### A. His \_\_\_\_\_ (14)

1. \_\_\_\_\_ Cloud (14a) = clouds are the garments of deity and speak of Christ's unapproachable holiness
2. Son of Man (14b) = pictures the Lord Jesus in His gloried humanity
3. Golden \_\_\_\_\_ (14c) = royal or kingly crowns
4. Sharp Sickle (14d) = curved razor like instrument that looks like a question mark and was used for harvesting wheat

#### B. His \_\_\_\_\_ (15-16)

### **Parable of the Tares (Matthew 13:24-30, 36-43)**

- "Sower" = Son of Man or the Lord Jesus who is Lord of the harvest
- " \_\_\_\_\_ " = World
- "Good seed" = children of kingdom; the saved

- " \_\_\_\_\_ " = children of wicked one; the unsaved
- "Enemy" = the devil
- " \_\_\_\_\_ " = end of the world or age
- "Reapers" = angels of God

## II. THE \_\_\_\_\_ (14:15)

" \_\_\_\_\_ " = becoming dry or withered. The picture is that of overripe fruit that has begun to rot. It signifies the rotten moral condition of a world that has become ripe for judgement.

## III. THE \_\_\_\_\_ (14:17-20)

### A. The Vision of \_\_\_\_\_ (vs. 17-18)

John is given a preview of the final destruction of the Beast and his armies as they are arrayed against Christ at His coming. (*Revelation 19:15*)

### B. A \_\_\_\_\_ of Armageddon (vs. 19-20)

" \_\_\_\_\_ are fully ripe" = bursting with juice

"Winepress" = used to extract juice from the grape

This event will take place in the Valley of \_\_\_\_\_.

" \_\_\_\_\_ furlongs" = approximately 200 miles

"Horse's \_\_\_\_\_" = approximately 4 ½ feet
