- A. God works His will & His just plan in His time-v. 2a
- B. God will judge (with) uprightness in His time!!—v. 2b
- C. God is there when everything falls apart—v. 3a
- D. God maintains the pillars of the earth in the midst of the greatest upheaval—v. 3 b
- E. God rebukes the boastful-v. 4a
- F. God rebukes the wicked—v. 4b

 1) Horn is a symbol of strength

- 2) Horn is a symbol of pride
- 3) Horn is pictured as that of an animal like a bull or ox
- G. God repeats the rebuke of the wicked—v. 5a
- H. God rebukes the wicked with a warning to not speak with an arrogant neck—v. 5b
- I. God is the source of Exaltation/Promotion/Raising up and Putting Down—v. 6
- J. God is Judge—v. 7
- K. God is the source of fierce wrath and judgment
 - 1) He holds a cup of wrath in His hand
 - 2) The wine is foaming
 - 3) The wine is mixed
 - 4) God pours out this wine and makes people drink it!
 - → Psalm 11:6, Jeremiah 25:15-29, Revelation 18:6
 - 5) The all the wicked of the earth will drain the dregs
 - 6) The wicked will drink down the dregs—i.e. They will get the full force of this drink and it is not good.

- A. I MUST DECLARE GOD'S GOODNESS AND JUSTICE
- **B. I MUST SING PRAISES TO THE GOD OF JACOB**
- A. The horns of the wicked will be hewn off
- B. The horns of the righteous will be exalted
