Definitions

To Know

/yāda – PRONUNCIATION – yaw-dah'/ a primitive root

To know (properly, to ascertain by seeing); acknowledge, acquaintance(-ted with), advise, answer, appoint, assuredly, be aware, comprehend, consider, cunning, declare, be diligent, (can, cause to) discern, discover, familiar friend, privy to.

To Perceive

/bîn - PRONUNCIATION - bene/ a primitive root

To separate mentally (or distinguish), (generally) understand:—attend, consider, be cunning, diligently, direct, discern, eloquent, feel, inform, instruct, have intelligence, be prudent, regard, (can) skill(-full), teach, think, (cause, make to, get, give, have) understand(-ing), view, (deal) wise(-ly, man).

To Receive

/lāqaḥ – PRONUNCIATION – law-kakh'/ a primitive root to take (in the widest variety of applications):—accept, bring, buy, carry away, drawn, fetch, get, mingle, place, receive(-ing), reserve, seize, send for, take (away, -ing, up), use, win.

To Give

/nātan – PRONUNCIATION – naw-than'/ a primitive root

to give (put, make, etc.):—add, apply, appoint, ascribe, assign, bestow, cast, cause, charge, come, commit, consider, count, cry, direct, distribute, do, fasten, frame, hang (up), sing, slander, strike, (sub-) mit, suffer, trade, turn, weep, willingly, withdraw, yield.

Will Hear

/šāma – PRONUNCIATION – shaw-mah'/ a primitive root

to hear intelligently (often with implication of attention, obedience, etc.; causatively, to tell, etc.):—call (gather) together, consent, consider, be content, declare, discern, listen, make (a) noise, (be) obedient, obey, perceive, (make a) proclaim(-ation), publish, regard, report, witness.
