II. Breaking Occult Bondage

A.	Announce your commitment to Christ and submission to His truth and righteousness alone (Ja. 4:6-8, Mat. 5:6).
В.	Ask God to any and all occult activity that has taken place in your life (Psa. 139:23-24)
C.	God to take back all ground lost through your involvement in darkness (2 Cor. 10:3-4, 2 Cor. 4:2).
D.	Burn what can be burned and break and bury what cannot be burned (Acts 19:13-20).
Е.	a tower of truth to run to when you have intruding thoughts trying to bring you back into bondage (2 Cor. 10:5).
