## The Beginning of Gracious Deliverance

Genesis 6:8-7:1 *Beginning* Pastor Phil Winfield November 3, 2013

*Lk 17:26 And as it was in the days of Noah, so it will be also in the days of the Son of Man.* <u>27</u> *They ate, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, and the flood came and destroyed them all.* 

God gave gracious deliverance.

- 1. God had a **<u>plan</u>** two main parts
  - a. God's plan was **judgment** of sin. (v.6-7) God is **incompatible** with sin and rebellion, period.
  - b. God's plan was one of grace. 6:3,8
- 2. God gave a <u>man</u> 6:8-13.
  - a. Noah was a man of **Sovereign** design. 5:28-29
  - b. Noah found **God's Grace**. 6:8
  - *c.* Noah found grace by <u>faith</u>. 6:9; 7:1
  - d. Noah demonstrated his faith by **<u>obedience</u>**. 6:22; 7:5
- 3. God provided a **Boat** 
  - a. The Ark was **sufficient**. (6:14-21)
  - b. The **<u>flood</u>** was sufficient.
  - c. The flood was <u>effective</u>. it went everywhere and involved everyone.
  - d. The Ark brought **<u>deliverance</u>**.
    - i. God is not helpless. "But God" 6:8; 8:1
    - ii. Man is not hopeless 2 Peter 2:9
- 4. God is still **graciously** giving.
  - a. God <u>has a plan</u>. He sent the "seed of the woman." (Gen 3:15) <u>Jesus!</u>
  - b. God **gave a man**. <u>Is 9:6</u>
  - c. God provided the <u>Cross</u> [Screen only] 1 Co 1:18 For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are <u>perishing</u>, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.

In chapter 7 Verse 16 What does it mean, God **<u>shut</u>** the door? Then it was **<u>too</u> <u>late</u>**.
