- 2. In what ways do the Gibeonites prove themselves as faithful followers of Yahweh in Chapter 10?
- 3. The text leaves no doubt who wins the battle of Gibeon. What details from the text attribute the victory to God and God alone?
- 4. Why is it significant that "the Lord listened to the voice of a man?"
- 5. How do you balance God's sovereignty with the admonition from Scripture to "pray without ceasing?" Why do we pray?
