1. What stood out to you from the sermon?
2. What are some ways we struggle to believe in our Father's riches of grace and mercy? How can this be comforting to us? (Eph 1:7; 2:4, 6; Ex 34:6)
3. What types of unity has Jesus secured through the cross? How can we praise him for this? What implications does this have for how we think about ourselves and others? (Eph 1:10; 2:13-14 16; 4:16)
4. What is the significance of the Spirit's presence in our lives? (Eph 2:19-22; Jn 17:20-23; 1 Jn 1:3; 2 Pet 1:4)
5. Which of the three persons of the Trinity do you think of the least? How can you grow in your appreciation and worship of God as both one and three?
