**The BIG Idea** ... \_\_\_\_\_ writes every chapter of our story with the \_\_\_\_\_ in mind. Philippians 1:6 ...

### The Dilemma

- \_\_\_\_\_ is husband to \_\_\_\_\_. They are parents to \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.
  - This family lives in \_\_\_\_\_ during the worst of times. Why is it the worst of times?
    - These are the days when the \_\_\_\_\_ ruled. Ruth's story is here to give us hope by showing us that His \_\_\_\_\_ hand is always at work—even in the worst of times.

### The Decision

Applications:
