1 At verse 22 the Psalm breaks from crucifixion to resurrection; fulfilled in the "Go to my brethren," etc., of John 20. 17. The risen Christ declares to His brethren the name, "Father."

2 Cf. v. 30. The kingdom is Jehovah's. In verse 30 Adonai is in view as ruling on behalf of Jehovah. See Psa. 110., with Mt. 22. 42-45. The great end and object of the rule of Adonai (Lord) is the restoration of the kingdom to Jehovah (LORD). See 1 Cor. 15. 23, 24. See "Names of Deity," Gen. 2. 4, note; Gen. 15. 2, note.
