<b>Scripture:</b>	Ephesians 2:1-10

## RECEIVE

- Read the passage and listen to Sunday's sermon (if you have not done so already).
- Ask God to help you understand and respond to the passage in faith.
- Reread the passage, taking note of any words or phrases that stand out.

## REFLECT

- In reading and thinking about Paul's description of what we were, how do you think a typical unbeliever would respond to this description of them selves?
- How did you respond when these gospel truths were initially shared with you? Think about how you can use your experience to better share the gospel with others.
- Meditate and reflect upon the words "But God " and what they truly mean to you? Write a list of all that God has done, continues to, and will do for you.
- What is the relationship between grace and works and how is this dynamic functioning in your own life?

## RESPOND

- How will you apply any gospel encouragement from your reading and reflection for the day and week ahead?
- What areas of your life have you identified that need to have gospel truth applied, in order for you to receive grace and peace from God?
- Spend some time in prayer with the Lord about the things He has revealed to you in this passage.
- Ask God to help you respond in faith to His word.
- Commit to applying whatever gospel encouragement or challenge you have received into practice.
