Sermon Outline

A Vision of the Throne of God

Rev. 4:1-11

- I. **Intro:** Seeing history from a heavenly perspective

- II. **Exposition:** God reigns supreme above all creation
 - A. John translated to the heavenly realm (vv.1-2)

 - B. A description of the majesty and glory of God enthroned (vv.2-6)
 1. Magnificent in beauty (v.3)

 2. Awesome in power (vv.5-6a)

 - C. A description of the royal attendants and their activity
 1. The four living creatures - cherubim (vv.6b-8; Ez 1,10; Is 6:3)
 - Continually praising God for who He is (vv.8; 5:8; 7:11)

 2. The twenty four elders (vv.4,9-11)
 - Continually worshipping God for His marvelous works (vv.11; 5:8; 7:12; 11:16; 19:4)

- III. **Application:** We see in this passage:
 1. A model for true worship: Adoration, God-exalting, man-debasing, with reverence and awe

 2. A God who is worthy of our continual worship

 3. A call to examine our view of God
