Introduction

- 1. One of the chief reasons for the destruction of the northern kingdom later in history was their great apostasy in worship.
- 2. Old Testament history is Christ centered important part of the text is the promise of Christ's coming.

The Authoritative Word

- 1. As Jeroboam institutes this new, innovative worship at Bethel, Jehovah commissioned a prophet from Judah to bring His word of judgment.
- 2. Jehovah expresses His displeasure and judgment through the prophet's words and signs.
 - a. First, let us consider the words that the prophet spoke in Verse 2. Two things striking:
 - b. Second, God declares with the sign that this judgment will certainly take place.

The Powerful Illustration

- 1. What happened the prophet died because he disobeyed God's word.
- 2. Why did this happen? The main point is that the carcass of this prophet was an illustration of Jehovah's judgment upon disobedience what would happen to Israel.

The Lessons Learned

- 1. This history speaks to the church today about the seriousness of changing the worship of the church.
- 2. We learn from this history to respond in a right way.
